**Getting Here** 

Our Region is **MARLBOROUGH**, the two main towns are **BLENHEIM** and **PICTON**, which is our nearest town. We are 30 minutes by boat from the seaside township of **Picton**.



**ROAD:** There are no roads in or out of the Resort.

WATER: Regular boat services (water-taxis) depart Picton throughout the day to the Resort.

AIR: You can also travel directly to the Resort via Helicopter or floatplane with or without going through Picton

PICTON itself is easily accessible by rail, sea, air and road.

# FROM CHRISTCHURCH TO MARLBOROUGH

Fly Air New Zealand from CHRISTCHURCH Airport to BLENHEIM AIRPORT (Marlborough) Blenhiem Airport to Picton is a 30 minute road trip – shuttles (private or shared) and taxis are available

Train http://www.kiwirailscenic.co.nz/coastal-pacific/ Travel to Picton on Tranzcoastal rail A delighful journey predominantly along the coast Daily departures in summer Possible restrictions in winter

#### Drive

A scenic drive along the East coast – allow about four and a half hours We recommend a stop at Ohau Point north of Kaikoura to walk to the small waterfall and view the seals

#### Boat – Interislander www.interislander.co.nz

The Inter-islander ferry is a scenic journey from Wellington Harbour to Picton departing three times a day. Takes approximately 3 hours We recommend the early departure (around 8.15am) and the Premium Lounge where wifi, food and drinks are available in a more comfortable setting

Floatplane www.nz-scenic-flights.co.nz Fly from Porirua Harbour – about 35 minutes north of Wellington 25 minute scenic flight maximum 5 persons NOTE: WEATHER DEPENDENT! Luggage can be limited

#### Drive

Hire a rental car in Nelson Allow one hour and 45 minutes for this enjoyable drive through the 'top of the South' *Take the scenic Queen Charlotte drive route* 

#### Shuttle or private vehicle

Enjoy the journey – let someone else do the driving Around two hours. Private or shared trips available – prices vary There is also a BUS service between Nelson and Blenheim/Picton
